DIRECTIVE 2010/63/EU OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL of 22 September 2010

on the protection of animals used for scientific purposes

- The provisions of the law
- 2. Ethics related to the relationship between humans and animals, the intrinsic value of life and the arguments for and against the use of animals for scientific purposes
- 3. Replacement, reduction and refinement (3 R's)
- 4. Design of experiments with reference to the 3 R's.
- 5. Quality assurance, deviation handling and notification (NINA system)
- 6. Animal behavior- general introduction to fear, pain, stress and other impacts for/on animals
- 7. Anesthesia, pain relief and euthanasia
- 8. Use of humane endpoints
- 9. Animal health work and hygiene
